#### 2023: Year in Review:

We are proposing the SLA BoD communicates with you, the members at least quarterly updates (ex: Jan / April / July / Oct) and to keep you informed about the SLA lakes, and local activities and events, and to remind you we're here for your ideas, insights and questions throughout the year.

#### **2024 Plans:**

Membership: (currently we are 115 members, and growing!)

New members: The BoD plans on organizing a 2024 new member initiative – likely in the spring/summer. We will update you in our next SLA member communication about the timing. Promoting the SLA: We are also looking at ways to further promote the SLA via events such as the Lakes & Trails Festival, and/or a county fair, with a focus on keeping membership to residents of the SLA lakes so we are true to our Mission and our Constitution.

Other ways to contribute: We will also be connecting with South Frontenac Township (SFT) Mayor and council to discuss how/where SLA can further our influence and support of SFT.

#### **Financials:**

Our fiscal year end is May 31. The SLA December '23 cash balance was \$6,443. This is in line with our 10-year average \$6,478. There are no major expenditures or donations forecasted for the remainder of this fiscal year. In Fiscal Year '23, SLA donated \$500 to Sydenham Lake Canada Day celebrations.

#### Water levels:

<u>Water:</u> It was a dry fall for lakes in the South Frontenac area. The water levels in 2023 continued to be well-managed by SFT and the CRCA.

Late ice: Late ice continues to be monitored as it results is higher than usual evaporation.

<u>Debris at the Syd Damn.</u> We ask you to please remember to get tree and construction cuts out of the lake, as these block the flow of water at the Sydenham Lake damn, and the outflow just after the damn. Thank you!

- This event will not be in Sydenham in 2024. A SFT decision was made in 2023 to rotate this
  event between Sydenham, Storrington (July 1, '24), and Portland (July 1, '25). There is a
  rotation of these three municipalities over the coming years.

# **Annual General Meeting (AGM):**

At the '23, AGM the majority of those in attendance asked that the next event by held in the Sydenham High School Auditorium, and that the event have an on-site SLA-managed BBQ, or we have the event catered.
